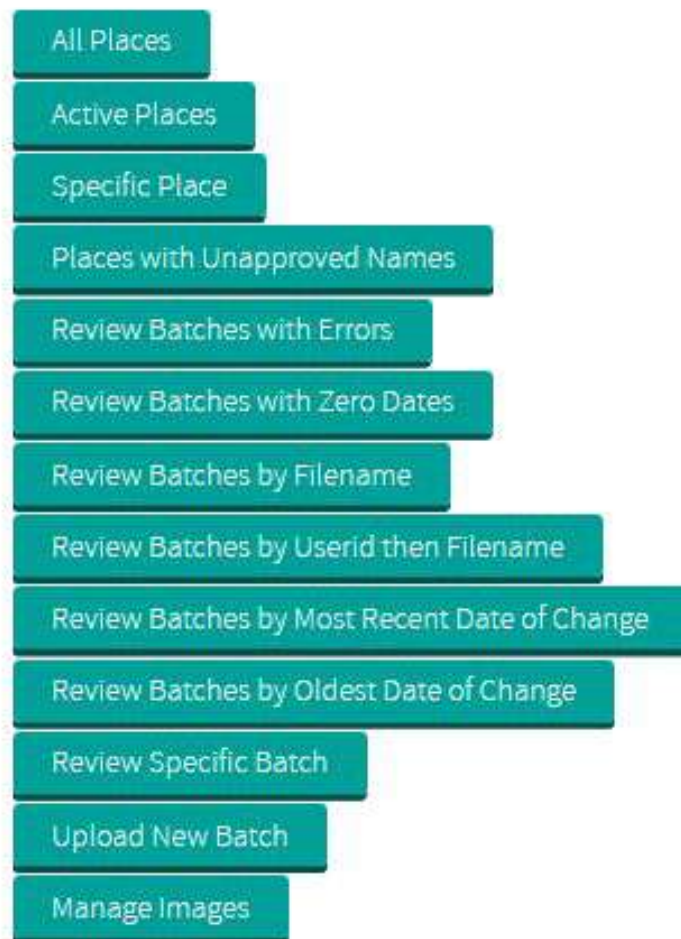

Phase 1.7 Researcher Enhancements

Targeted actors: Researchers

Features

- GAP integrated with DAP (medium)
- Maternal birth name search (small)
- Double-barrelled surnames (in progress) (small-medium)
- Explore Banns record type support (x-large)
- Researchers can register to get access to extra facilities (extra small)
- Consider 'premium' service for paying researchers (e.g. adfree)
- Researchers can post alternate record interpretations (large)
- Researchers can subscribe to receive emails when registers change (small)
- Saved Search feature are accessible to registered users (small)
- Researchers can leave bouquets (in progress) (small)
- ~~Transcriber's notes visible to researchers (complete)~~
- Review and selected implementation of outstanding suggestions for researchers
- Provide database statistics (medium)
